Re: Request for Confidential Treatment of Information Submitted (AQ25-001)

Dear Mr. Simshauser:

On behalf of Kia America, Inc., and Kia Corporation (collectively “Kia”), Kia America, Inc., (“KUS”) hereby requests that certain documents submitted in its response to AQ25-001 dated September 10, 2025 be treated as confidential. Kia is seeking confidential treatment of certain documents in their entirety as well as partial confidential treatment of its written response. In accordance with 49 C.F.R. 512.3(c), confidential business information includes trade secrets or commercial or financial information that is privileged or confidential as described in the Freedom of Information Act. See 5 U.S.C. 522(b)(4). Commercial information is considered confidential if it has not been publicly disclosed and if its release is likely to cause substantial harm to Kia’s competitive position. 49 C.F.R. 512.3.

The documents for which Kia is seeking confidentiality were prepared by Kia and contains confidential business information. These documents include the following:

- Certain portions of Kia’s written response dated September 10, 2025;
- Internal engine evaluations in response to Request No. 4 (TAB 1 and TAB 2); and
- Calculation and analysis of the engine vibration inspection results in response to Request Nos., 5 through 8 (TAB 3 and TAB 4).

The documents above contain the type of information that is not customarily disclosed to the public as it reveals confidential business information that, if made public, would allow Kia’s competitors the benefit of knowing its engineering and internal product investigations, evaluations and decision-making processes.
