SUBJECT: 1,163,000 DaimlerChrysler 1996-2000 Dodge Caravan/Grand Caravan, Plymouth Voyager/Grand Voyager, and Chrysler Town & Country mini vans equipped with 3.3L or 3.8L gasoline engines and manufactured from mid-February 1995 through early September 1999. Nitrile O-ring seals in the fuel rail could degrade over time and extended exposure to elevated temperatures. Fuel leakage from the underhood fuel injection fuel rail delivery system could result, possibly resulting in a fire.
