**SUBJECT: 130 Nissan 2001 Quest mini vans manufactured from SOP through October 11, 2000. These vehicles may have the plastic trim cover around the base of the front seat safety belt buckle trapped between the shoulder of the restraint anchorage bolt and the seat pedestal. The restraint buckle anchorage may not have the intended clamp load.**

This is an initial acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be forthcoming shortly. After our review of your report and associated documents, we may have additional comments or concerns.

As stated in your report, all vehicles are at dealerships and have not been sold. Dealers will replace the seat belt buckle assemblies. No owner notification is involved.
