This letter is being sent in response to our recent telephone conversation in which you requested a letter stating the date by which General Motors will begin mailing recall notification letters to owners of vehicles involved in the recall of certain 1999 model-year C/K pick-up trucks and sport utility vehicles. The subject of this recall and a more specific identification of the involved vehicles are contained in my letter to you, dated April 27, 2000.

General Motors intends to mail letters to dealers during the week of November 20, 2000 and to vehicle owners during the week of November 27, 2000.
