Please be advised that there has been some error in the previously informed completion rate of recall no: 00V311-002.

Initially, recall 00V311-002 was issued for the Crankshaft Pulley Bolt of certain Montero, Montero Sport, and Mirage. This recall included a total of 61,068 vehicles. Later on, recall 01V340-002 was issued only for Mirage vehicles. This second recall included a total of 8,887 vehicles. By mistake, at the time of issuance of this second recall, our personnel incorrectly added these 8,887 vehicles to recall 00V311-002, improperly elevating the number of affected vehicles as well as the amount of units repaired.

We proceeded to separate the affected vehicles into their respective recall reference numbers. However, before this error was noticed, a quarterly report for recall 00V311-002 was sent to you. Needless to say, this quarterly report stated an incorrect completion rate for this recall.

Since this error was corrected in our system, we are now properly tracking the completion rate of both of these recalls separately, and have revised our next quarterly report accordingly. A renotification to customers will be performed in accordance to your notification no. NSA-11kjs / OR02-008.

We apologize for any inconvenience this situation may cause.


