Mitsubishi Motor Sales of Caribbean, Inc., submits this letter for purposes of compliance with the quarterly reporting requirements of 49 C.F.R. Section 573.6. The following information is submitted for the calendar quarter ending December 31, 2003. This recall involves the following vehicles distributed by MMSC: *1997-1999 Mirage model vehicles manufactured from March 1996 through February 1998, 1992-1998 Montero model vehicles manufactured from January 1991 through March 1998, and 2001 Montero Sport manufactured from August 98 through March 99.*
