**SUBJECT: Approximately 327 GM 2002 Saturn VUE sport utility vehicles fail to comply with the requirements of FMVSS No. 210, "Seat Belt Assembly Anchorages." Some vehicles were produced with rear occupant outer seat belt shoulder guide anchor bolts that were incorrectly installed. *Saturn Recall No. 02-C-04.***

This is an acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be written if we have additional comments or concerns.

I have reviewed your draft owner/dealer notifications and they meet the requirements of Part 577.
