OWNER'S MANUAL UPDATE – CHILD RESTRAINT ANCHORAGE SYSTEMS

Dear DaimlerChrysler Minivan Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

DaimlerChrysler Corporation has determined that the Owner's Manual of some 2002 model year Dodge Caravan/Grand Caravan and Chrysler Voyager and Town & Country minivans equipped with 7-passenger seating may not comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 225 – Child Restraint Anchorage Systems.

The Owner's Manual that was supplied with your minivan (identified on the enclosed form) incorrectly states that all rear seating locations are equipped with Lower Anchors and Tether for CHILDren (LATCH) child restraint anchorage systems and additional child seat tether anchors. This notice is intended to correct that error.

The LATCH systems on your minivan are located at both of the middle (2nd) row seating positions. This is true whether the vehicle is equipped with a bench seat or dual bucket seats. An additional tether anchor is located at the center seating position of the rear (3rd) row bench seat.

IMPORTANT: To ensure that this information is available for reference by you or future owners of the vehicle, please place this letter with your minivan's owner's manual in the glove box or storage compartment.
