**SUBJECT: Approximately 34,086 Hyundai 2000, 2001 and 2002 Accent 3-door vehicles manufactured from September 16, 1999 through October 19, 2001, fail to comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 201, "Occupant Protection in Interior Impact." During testing, the 3-door hatchback exceeded the performance criterion in the standard at one location, AP3, approximately midway along the length of the right windshield support pillar (right A-pillar).
*Hyundai Recall No. 055.***
