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SUBJECT: 332,950 Volkswagen 2000-2001 Golf model vehicles manufactured from September 1, 1999 through January 28, 2001, and 2000-2001 Jetta, Cabrio, and New Beetle model vehicles manufactured from September 1, 1999 through January 4, 2001, fail to comply with requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 225, "Child Restraint Anchorage systems." Child seat anchorages installed in the vehicle's rear seats must be identified by markings, and their location and use be described in the Owner's Manual. These vehicles were not marked or described as required by the standard. VWoA Recall No. UW.

This is an acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be written only if we have additional comments or concerns.

Under 49 U.S.C. § 30112(a), it is illegal for anyone, including a manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or retailer to sell an item of equipment or vehicle that fails to comply with all applicable Federal motor vehicle safety standards.

I have reviewed your draft owner notification letter and it meets the requirements of Part 577.

As stated in Part 573.6, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter **in which notification to purchasers occurs**. As stated in your report, owner notification is expected to begin September 15, 2002. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due by October 30, 2002.
