SUBJECT: 670,740 MY 2000 & 2001 Malibu, Alero, and Grand Am vehicles. These vehicles have hazard warning switches that may experience solder joint cracking caused by rapid temperature transitions and the soldering process. If solder joint cracking occurs and results in an open circuit, the turn signals/hazard lamps become intermittent or inoperative. When the turn signals are inoperative, the driver cannot use them to signal intent to turn which could result in a vehicle crash.

This is an acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be written only if we have additional comments or concerns.

This recall is the result of an investigation, EA02-037, conducted by the Office of Defects Investigation.
