SUBJECT: 416 Four Winds 2004-2005 Hurricane, Infinity, and Windsport motor homes. On certain motor homes, the fuel lines on the chassis could chafe against the steel floor structure, causing the fuel line to rupture.

This is an acknowledgment of an amendment to this recall which will expand the scope of the recall. An additional 221 motor homes has been added to this campaign which also includes the additional of some 2005 model year motor homes.

As stated in the amended report, Four Winds will use the dealer/owner notification letters that were sent in connection with the initial phase of the recall campaign to notify the dealers of the additional vehicles and to also notify the 221 additional owners. These letters will be sent out during April 2005.

Four Winds will provide NHTSA with three additional quarterly reports which will include the additional 221 motor homes.
