SUBJECT: 196 Monaco 2004-2005 Camelot, Windsor, 2005 Diplomat, Knight, Holiday Scepter, Ambassador, Endeavor, Safari Gazelle, and Beaver Santiam motor homes. The water heater exhaust on the curve side wall under the back side of the kitchen slideout room box terminates under the slide box when in the extended position. This design could create a risk of migration of carbon monoxide into the interior of the motor home. Monaco Recall No. R04047.
