This letter is written to notify the NHTSA that Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc., is aware of the voluntary initiation of a Recall Notification Campaign affecting Fleetwood produced recreational vehicles as listed below:

This voluntary recall campaign is being conducted by Airxcel Companies, P.O. Box 4020, Wichita, Kansas 67204. Phone: 719-676-2326

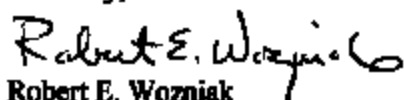
This voluntary recall campaign involves approximately 735 Fleetwood purchased solar panels for Polar Mach & Polar Cub RV Air-Conditioners.

The reason for the recall is that in some instances the rubber well nuts fractured the plastic shroud in the immediate area of the attachment hole. In other instances the rubber well nuts may not have engaged the hole adequately to prevent them from being pulled out of the plastic shroud during normal use. In either instance it is possible for the solar panel to leave the top of the motor home and either cause an accident or become a road hazard.

To assist Airxcel in conducting this recall campaign, Fleetwood has provided dealer and owner of record information.

Fleetwood has no reason to disagree with this action or the recall remedy. Fleetwood is relying on Airxcel Companies and the NHTSA to monitor campaign performance.
