BMW is amending its July 14, 2004 Part 573 report pertaining to the referenced matter.


We are revising the number of potentially affected vehicles in section 3 to state as follows:

3. The number of vehicles affected is approximately 635 5-Series, 731 6-Series, 676 7-Series, and 2,025 X5 models.

We are also revising one sentence within the section 5 description to state as follows:

5. ...The assembly error in the misbuilt control units can lead to a failure of the functionality of the control units after a short period of operation.
