Dear Associate Administrator:

Pursuant to 49 CFR Part 573, Monaco Coach Corporation ("Monaco" or the "Company") is submitting this report to NHTSA concerning a recall campaign, which is being voluntarily initiated. Specific information is as follows:

573.5(c)(2)

Affected vehicles are specific model year **2004 Beaver Patriot** Class A Motorhomes.

Affected units were built December 12, 2002 through November 20, 2003. The recall population was determined from the manufacturing records from the Company's manufacturing plant in Coburg, Oregon that produced the affected motorhomes.

573.5(c)(3)

A total of Ninety-Five (95) motorhomes are in the recall population. Specific Serial Number and VIN break points are as follows:

2004 Beaver Patriot with a starting Serial Number 041620834088302-800528 through 041620834088401-800865 with the VIN range of 1RFC3561643024673 through 1RFC6561741028959.

573.5(c)(4)

Monaco has determined that all of the motorhomes in this recall population need to have the repair performed.

573.5(c)(5)

Monaco Coach Corporation has become aware that the Federal Identification Label contains incorrect information regarding the rim size and tire inflation rating as well as an incorrect rating for the GVWR and front GAWR. The initial label states the rim size as 22.5X9H Range with an inflation of 125 psi, a GVWR of 46,300 lbs. and a front GAWR of 15,300 lbs. when the correct rim size should be 22.5X8.25H Range with a tire inflation of 120 psi, a GVWR of 45,780 lbs. and a front GAWR of 14,780 lbs.. The affected units fail to conform to 49 CFR 571.110 (FMVSS No. 110 – Tire Selection and Rims)

573.5(c)7

This error occurred during the manufacturing process when information for another model manufactured on the same production line was inadvertently entered for the Patriot model.

573.5(c)8

The remedy will involve installing a corrected Federal Identification Label on the affected motorhomes.


All motorhomes in Monaco's inventory have been corrected.

Copies of the owner and dealer notification letters and the repair instructions are forthcoming for your pre-approval. The Company is prepared to begin dealer notification August 30, 2004 and owner notification September 6, 2004.
