

Defect description:

A wire harness located in the trunk hinge area is not adequately protected and, over time, could be damaged when the trunk is opened and closed. A damaged harness can cause a blown fuse (short) or an open circuit; either results in a loss of license plate light, back-up light and/or taillight function. All affected lights are located on the trunk lid. The portion of the light assembly located on the rear quarter panel, which includes a taillight, a brake light and a turn signal, is not affected. Loss of a taillight could reduce visibility and increase the risk of a vehicle crash.

Chronology:

Apr. 16, 2004 During internal testing, HMC discovered the loss of rear lamp

function due to a demaged harness and initiated an investigation.

Aug. 26, 2004 HMC completed the Investigation and determined that a safety-

related defect exists.

Program for remedying the defect:

The owners of all affected vehicles will be notified by mail and asked to take their vehicle to an authorized Acura dealer. The dealer will inspect the harness. If any damage is found, the harness will be replaced, free of charge. If no damage is found, the dealer will install corrugated plastic tubing over the harness to prevent damage. Reimbursement will not be necessary because the affected vehicles are still covered under the new vehicle warranty.
