In response to a letter from your office dated October 18, 2004 regarding a review of defect notice 04E-058, Starcraft Bus and Mobility, a division of Forest River, Inc. hereby submits the following information regarding NHTSA Recall EQ04-022:

Pursuant to 49 U.S.C § 30166, Starcraft Bus and Mobility hereby provides information regarding the potential vehicles affected by the suspect equipment manufactured by Sure-Lok, Inc.:

1. Starcraft Bus and Mobility has received information regarding the range of dates and quantity of retractors sold to Starcraft Bus and Mobility that may be suspect product from Sure-Lok, Inc. This information was received on October 22, 2004. The total quantity of retractors sold to Starcraft Bus and Mobility from December 31, 1997 to July 31, 2004 is 518. Please note that retractors sold to Starcraft Bus and Mobility prior to September 1, 2001 were purchased prior to Forest River ownership. Of the total 518 listed above, 478 retractors were purchased under Forest River ownership.
2. At this time, Starcraft Bus and Mobility is currently in the process of identifying the customer base in support of the recall in question.
3. Once this information has been collected, it will be forwarded to Sure-Lok for the purposes of this recall.
