

Dear Mr. Weinstein:

This will amend our Part 573 Report dated December 10, 2004 by providing the following information:

## 573.6(c)(2)(i) Identification of Vehicles or Equipment

2004 and 2005 Touareg vehicles manufactured from March 26, 2003 to September 20, 2004 (VIN range WVG \_ \_ 7L\_4D000056 to WVG \_ \_ 7L\_5D030829).

#### 573.6(c)(8) Proposed Remedial Action

Volkswagen notified dealers on January 6, 2005 of this non-compliance and published the enclosed recall circular. Volkswagen will notify owners on or before March 28, 2005 of the recall and provide an owner's manual insert as discussed with NHTSA OVSC. Dealers will permanently install a "clip" in each of the two rear outboard seat belts. The clips will prevent unwanted deactivation of the ALR mode with child seat installations.

### 573.6(c)(9) Proposed Remedial Action

Volkswagen will submit copies of draft owner communications no less than five business days before the intended mailing date.

## 573.6(c)(9) Campaign Number

Volkswagen has assigned the code "UY" to this action.
