SUBJECT: **127,285 MY 2003-2004 Saturn ION passenger vehicles equipped with 2.2L 4-cylinder (L61) engines and manufactured from June 2002 through September 2003. These vehicles were built with a fuel filter that could corrode prematurely on the exterior surface. GM Recall No. 03068.**
