SUBJECT: 37 Newmar 2001-2002 NewAire motor homes equipped with Bosch ZOPS braking calipers and pads. The ZOPS braking can develop a dragging of the pads on the rotor surface due to the pin slide not allowing the pads to retract away from the surface. A hang up or lock up may cause the calipers to overheat and not allow the motorhome driver to stop safely.

Please provide us with the beginning and ending dates of production for these motor homes.

Also, please provide us with a draft owner notification letter before mailing to owners.

As stated in Part 573.6, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, owner notification is expected to begin February 27, 2004. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due by April 30, 2004.
