SUBJECT: 963 Western 1998-2003 Alpine Coach motorhomes manufactured from August 19, 1997 through January 22, 2003. A 250-amp ground/fuse was used to protect battery ground. The fuse protecting the positive side of the battery was rated for 300 amps.
