**SUBJECT:** Monaco is expanding this recall campaign to include an additional 57 MY 2004 Holiday Rambler Ambassador and 2004 Monaco Knight Class A motor homes. The I-beam leaf imitator in the front axle suspension can crack and break due to an inadequate welding process. The rear axle panard bracket that is welded to the curbside top of the rear axle housing can break due to an inadequate welding process and a design deficiency. *Monaco Recall No. R03024.*
