SUBJECT: 4 Triple E 2004 Empress and Embassy motorhomes equipped with an Acme heater fan speed resistor pack. The 12volt wires and vacuum line routed behind or under the resistor pack may overheat and melt from the heat generated from the heater. (Triple E Recall No. CA#4943-04)

We have reviewed your proposed owner notifications and it needs to have the following changes made as shown on the attached owner notification letter.

As stated in Part 573.6 submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. If letters were already mailed to consumers on January 28, 2004, you do not need to renotify. However, if the letter has not yet been mailed then the corrections have to be made first. Owner notification is expected to begin during January or February 2004. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due April 30, 2004.
