SUBJECT: 4,100 MY 2004 Cayenne, Cayenne S and Cayenne Turbo sport utility vehicles. Some vehicles may have had a transfer case installed that could, due to changes in the housing casting, result in the oil pump rotation. Should this occur, oil starvation of the internal gears might result. Continued operation of the vehicle could result in a fracture of the transfer case housing.
