SUBJECT: 735 Fleetwood 2004 Expedition, Providence, Discovery, Bounder Diesel, Excursion, and Revolution motor homes equipped with Airxcel air conditioning solar panels. During installation, the rubber well nuts may not have engaged the hole adequately to prevent them from being pulled out of the plastic shroud during normal use. Should the panel detach while the vehicle is in motion, it could strike another vehicle or a pedestrian, possibly resulting in personal injuries

Please provide us with the beginning and ending manufacturing dates of these motor homes.

It is our understanding that Airxcel (04E-007) will be conducting this recall.
