**SUBJECT: Approximately 491 Mitsubishi 2004 Montero and Montero Sport sport utility vehicles manufactured from August 20, 2003 through January 29, 2004. The vehicle capacity weights as stated on the tire and loading information label are in error and could potentially result in consumers loading their vehicles beyond the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR).**
