SUBJECT: 255 Hino 2005 NC6J, ND8J, and NV8J trucks manufactured from October 2003 through January 2004, fail to comply with requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 108, "Lamps, Reflective Devices, and Associated Equipment." During a quality inspection, water penetration from a prewash step was found on the reverse backup switch.
