SUBJECT: 13,757 Nissan 2004 Quest vehicles manufactured from March 26, 2003 through September 2, 2003, fail to comply with the advanced air bag requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 208, "Occupant Crash Protection." For the front passenger seating position, the automatic suppression feature option was chosen. The front passenger seat is equipped with a seat cushion bladder and sensors that are used for occupant detection under the standard. When the AC06 child dummy was placed in the required positions, automatic suppression may not occur.

This is an acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be written if we have additional comments or concerns.

Please provide a draft owner notification letter for our review before mailing to consumers.

As stated in Part 573.6, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, distributor/owner notification is expected to begin during May 2004. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due in this office by July 30, 2004.
