SUBJECT: An additional 769 MY 1999-2000 FLHP Touring and Police model motorcycles will be added to the original recall population. The 40 amp main circuit breaker can "open" for reasons other than which it was designed, causing an unexpected interruption of all electrical power to the motorcycle. This condition could cause a "quit while riding" situation, which could result in a crash.

This is an acknowledgment for the expanded portion of this recall.
