SUBJECT: 95 Jayco 2003-2004 F36Z Talon recreational 5th wheel vehicles manufactured from January 25, 2002 through October 20, 2003. The 1" by 1" steel angle, located on the front and rear of the axle plate which helps eliminate side to side movement of the axle plate, may not have been welded properly or may have been welded in an improper location.

Please provide us with a draft owner notification letter for our review before mailing to consumers and the estimated mailing date.

As stated in Part 573.6 submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the cost of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs.
