SUBJECT: 2,0³¹ International 2001-2004 Models 7300, 7400 and 7500 trucks equipped with DT466 or DT530 1308 style engines and 4x4 or 6x6 capability and manufactured from September 27, 2001 through March 8, 2004. Under certain braking conditions, the universal joint between the front drive shaft and the front drive axle could come in contact with the engine oil filter, possibly causing a puncture resulting in complete engine oil loss. *International Recall No. 04504.*

Please provide us with a draft owner notification letter for our review before mailing to consumers.
