SUBJECT: 99 Four Winds 2003 Dutchmen Express, Four Winds 5000, and Chateau Sport motor homes built on Chevrolet chassis and manufactured from September 2002 through February 2003. Some of the motor homes were manufactured with generators that may receive excess fuel supply pressure when the chassis engine is in operation, resulting in rough generator engine operation. This could cause fuel leakage at the generator carburetor area. (Four Winds Recall No. R030005)

This is an acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be written only if we have additional comments or concerns.

This recall was the subject of a Preliminary Evaluation, PE04-029, conducted by the Office of Defects Investigation.

We have reviewed your proposed owner notification letter and it meets the requirements of Part 577.

As stated in Part 573.6, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, owner notification is expected to begin during April 2004. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due by July 30, 2004.

NOTE: As stated in your report, 22 motor homes have already been corrected.
