SUBJECT: 11,375 GM 2004 Cadillac SRX model vehicles equipped with all wheel drive and manufactured from March 2003 through January 2004. The antiflock brake system (ABS) may temporarily isolate the driver from the foundation brake system for a maximum of 1.25 seconds and result in an increase in braking distance. GM Recall No. 04018.
