
SUBJECT: 76 Monaco 2004 Beaver Marquis Class A motor homes manufactured from December 9, 2002 through November 17, 2003. The pigtail connectors connecting the Soft Touch Ceiling Light to the coach wiring harness were not installed during manufacturing. This omission could lead to an overheating condition of the light and/or wire harness resulting in a fire. *Monaco Recall No. R04003.*

This is an acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be written only if we have additional comments or concerns.

We have reviewed your proposed owner notification letter and it meets the requirements of Part 577.

As stated in Part 573.6, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, owner notification is expected to begin during April 2004. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due by July 30, 2004.
