**SUBJECT: Harley-Davidson is expanding this recall to include additional Touring model motorcycles built between June 4, 2003 and August 22, 2003: FLHRSE12, FLHTCSE, FLHRS, and FLHRSI motorcycles. This number of motorcycles involved in the expanded population is 894. The tail light bulb can fall out of the socket, rendering the tail light and the brake light inoperative.**

Also after further review, Harley-Davidson has determined that the original population of 35,855 included some motorcycles that had been shipped outside the United States to other countries. The correct campaign population figure is **31,070** motorcycles, which includes the expanded 894 motorcycles.

We have reviewed your revised proposed owner notification letter and it meets the requirements of Part 577.
