SUBJECT: 35 Monaco 2004 Windsor and Holiday Rambler Imperial motorhomes. During the manufacturing process, these motor homes had a water line (Thermod value-flex/GS) installed to the Aqua-Hot Heating System unit when a fuel line (SAE-30R7) should have been installed. The incorrect line may allow seepage of fuel and vapors into the bay area of the motor home. *Monaco Recall No. R04010.*

This is an acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be written only if we have additional comments or concerns.

We have reviewed your proposed owner notification letter and it meets the requirements of Part 577.

As stated in Part 573.6, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs.
