SUBJECT: 10,200 Mazda 2001 MPV minivans equipped with cruise control and built between April 1, 2001, and November 15, 2001; and certain 2000-2001 MPV minivans equipped with cruise control built between March 31, 1999 and March 31, 2001, that have had the cruise control repaired and possibly had a defective cable installed during that repair. The cruise control actuator cable may be broken due to insufficient strength. *Mazda Recall No. 2004F.*
