SUBJECT: **86 PL Custom 2003 Medallion, Titan, Sentry, Rescue, and 2003-2004 Crusader emergency vehicles equipped with seat belts built by AmSafe. Some seat belt buckles fail to conform to the load requirement of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 209, "Seat Belt Assemblies."**

This is an acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be written only if we have additional comments or concerns.

Under 49 U.S.C. § 30112(a), it is illegal for anyone, including a manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or retailer to sell an item of equipment or vehicle that fails to comply with all applicable Federal motor vehicle safety standards.

This recall was the subject of an investigation, EQ04-009, conducted by the Office of Defects Investigation.

It is our understanding that AmSafe (04E-024) will be conducting the owner notification and remedy for this campaign.
