SUBJECT: 438,391 Chrysler 2001-2005 PT Cruiser passenger vehicles equipped with 2.4L non-turbo engines and automatic transaxles. Routing variation in the high pressure power steering hose could allow contact with the automatic transaxle differential cover, potentially damaging the bose.
