SUBJECT: **1,211 Mitsubishi 2004 Endeavor manufactured from March 11 through
April 15, 2004. The foot of the driver's side seat riser may develop a crack, resulting in
reduced strength of the seat anchorage. Mitsubishi Recall No. SR-04-006.**

We have reviewed your proposed owner notification letter and it meets the requirements of
Part 577. However, could you please change the word "collision" to "crash" per the
regulations.

purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, owner notification is expected to begin during
July 2004. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due by October 30, 2004.
