SUBJECT: 47,991 GM 2004 Chevrolet Impala, Monte Carlo, and Pontiac Grand Prix vehicles were produced with lower than specified torque on both front brake caliper to steering knuckle attachment bolts. With improper torque, the clamp load at the joint may not be adequate to prevent movement between the caliper bracket and knuckle. GM Recall No. 04049.

We have reviewed your proposed owner notification letter and it meets the requirements of Part 577.
