SUBJECT: 7,494 Honda 2002-2004 FSC600 motorcycles. The main stand is attached to the frame with two brackets, nuts and bolts. The nuts are spot-welded to the brackets. If clearance exists between the nut and bracket, the spot welds may be broken when the bolt is torqued. Over time, a bolt can loosen and fall out. *Honda Recall No. P37.*
