SUBJECT: **556 Ferrari 2003 360 Modena, 360 Spider, and 2004 360 Challenge Stradale. A slight oil leak in the hydraulic steering delivery pipe from the pump to the steering rack may occur which could lead to a gradual reduction of the assisted steering function. Ferrari Recall No. 41.**
