SUBJECT: **2,857 GM 2004 Pontiac Grand Am and Chevrolet Classic model vehicles may have been built with a fuel tank that does not meet specification. A weld on these fuel tanks may be insufficient, resulting in a fuel leak. GM Recall No. 04058.**
