SUBJECT: 159 Ameri-Camp 2003-2004 travel trailers and fifth wheel trailers equipped with Samsung microwave ovens. These microwaves were produced with a defective panel. An electrical short can occur between circuit patterns on the membrane panel, especially overlapped by a "jumper" or jump wire. An electrical short can occur causing the oven to activate without pressing any keypads. This could result in excessive heat, smoke, or possibly a fire.

This is an acknowledgment for this recall. A formal acknowledgment letter will be written only if we have additional comments or concerns.

As stated in your report, Samsung will be conducting the owner notification and remedy for this campaign.
