SUBJECT: 84,574 Subaru 2002-2003 Impreza sedan and wagon model vehicles. The left front bolt that retains the forward part of the drivers seat to the seat slide rail may loosen. If the seat slide rail bolt loosens it will eventually fall out and the seat may separate from the seat slide.
