SUBJECT: 10 Blue Bird MY 2005 Wanderlodge 45' motor homes manufactured from June 30 through September 27, 2004. An incorrect Bussbar cable connector was installed in the main power distribution box. Under high load conditions, arcing and shorting could occur which can destroy the Bussbar assembly and cause loss of power to the engine.

As stated in your report, all vehicles have been corrected. This recall is 100% complete.
