SUBJECT: 416 Honda 2004-2005 Civic Si passenger vehicles. Some front seat belt anchors may have been installed with an incorrect washer, which could restrict anchor movement. As a result, the seat belt may be improperly positioned for certain occupants. *Honda Recall No. P55.*
