PRODUCT SAFETY RECALL #04002 - DATED: FEBRUARY 2004

DESCRIPTION:

- General Motors has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 1998 model year Buick Skylark; 1998-2001 model year Chevrolet Cavalier; 1998 model year Oldsmobile Achieva; 1998 model year Pontiac Grand Am; and 1998-2001 model year Pontiac Sunfire vehicles. If the engine falls to start and the driver holds the key in the "start" position for an extended period, high current flows through the ignition switch, and sometimes produces enough heat to melt internal switch parts. If the switch is damaged, a fire could occur in the steering column, even with the engine off and the key removed. The fire could spread to the interior of the car, which could injure occupants of the car or cause damage to adjoining structures.
- Dealers are to Install a relay kit and verify that the vehicle will start with a properly charged battery in good.

- operating condition (adequate reserve capacity, or cold cranking amps).
- Refer to the Product Safety Recall Bulletin #04002 for further information.

EFFECTIVE DATE:

Due to part availability, this recall is being conducted in three phases. Phase 1 will consist of 1998-1999 vehicles; Phase 2 will consist of 2000 model year vehicles; and Phase 3 will consist of 2001 model year vehicles. When sufficient parts are available to notify customers of the 2000 and 2001 vehicles, you will be notified and will receive a new initiation report.

Owner mailing for Phase 1 is scheduled to begin March 1, 2004.
